OFFICIAL FIREARM RAFFLE RULES

The Founding Fathers Pistol (43 of 250)

(Auto Ordinance 1911 SN# AAP01039)

1. Sponsoring Organization

This raffle ("Raffle") is conducted by the 906 Foundation ("Foundation"), a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes § 13-3302(B). The 906 Foundation/PLEA Charities has been in continuous existence in Arizona for at least one year immediately preceding this Raffle.

2. Prize

One (1) Auto Ordinance 1911 firearm, serial number **AAP01039** with a stated fair market value of **\$2,500** ("Prize"). No cash value or substitution will be offered or permitted; the Prize cannot be exchanged, transferred prior to legal delivery, or redeemed for cash.

3. Eligibility to Purchase Tickets

To purchase a raffle ticket, a person must, at the time of purchase:

- Be a legal resident of the State of Arizona;
- Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age;

- Not be a current member of the 906 Foundation's Board of Directors, or a current employee of the Phoenix Law Enforcement Association (PLEA), each of whom is ineligible to purchase a ticket or win the Prize, along with their immediate household members; and
- Agree to these Official Rules, including the requirement to pass a federal firearms background check (see Section 7) before the Prize can be transferred.

Purchasing a ticket does not guarantee eligibility to receive the Prize; final eligibility is determined at the time of transfer under Section 7.

4. Ticket Price, Limits, and Sales Period

- Tickets are \$50.00 each.
- Maximum of five (5) tickets per person.
- A total of 250 tickets will be sold.
- Sales open July 8, 2026, and close on **July 31, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. (noon)**, or as soon as practicable once all 250 tickets have been sold, whichever occurs first.
- Tickets may be purchased online only, through 906foundation.org. No cash, check, or in-person sales will be accepted.
- **All ticket purchases are final and non-refundable**, regardless of whether the purchaser is later found ineligible to receive the Prize, the Raffle is modified, or for any other reason, except as required by law.

5. Drawing

- The drawing will be held on July 31, 2026, at 12:30 pm, conducted by random physical drum draw witnessed by PLEA officials.
- One winning ticket will be drawn at random from all validly purchased and paid tickets.
- One or more alternate/runner-up tickets will also be drawn at the same time and held in sequence, to be used only as provided in Sections 6 and 7.
- The drawing will be video recorded and witnessed by an independent third party to ensure verifiable randomness.

6. Notification and 14-Day Claim Period

- The 906 Foundation will attempt to notify the winning ticket holder using the contact information provided at purchase within 7 days of the drawing.
- The winner must respond to claim the Prize and begin the transfer process described in Section 7 within **fourteen (14) days** of the drawing.

- If the winner cannot be reached, does not respond, or does not complete the steps required to claim the Prize within this 14-day period, the Prize will be forfeited and awarded to the next runner-up in the order drawn, who will then have a new 14-day period to claim the Prize under the same terms.

7. Mandatory Firearms Transfer Requirements

Because the Prize is a firearm, transfer to any winner is governed by federal and Arizona law in addition to these Raffle rules, and is **separate from and in addition to** raffle-ticket eligibility under Section 3:

- The winner must undergo and pass a federal firearms background check (NICS check), conducted by **On Duty Direct Corp.**, a licensed Federal Firearms Licensee located at 1102 West Adams, Phoenix, AZ, 85007, [FFL license number 9-86-013-01-9E-18666].
- The winner must appear in person at On Duty Direct Corp., 1102 West Adams, complete ATF Form 4473, and pass the NICS check before taking possession of the firearm. No firearm will be released to the winner until the background check is passed and all federal paperwork is completed.
- In-person pickup will occur at On Duty Direct Corp., 1102 West Adams — the licensed FFL premises.
- If the drawn winner fails to pass the required background check, does not qualify under federal or Arizona law to lawfully possess a firearm, or otherwise cannot complete the transfer, the winner forfeits the Prize with no compensation of any kind, and the Prize will be awarded to the next runner-up ticket holder in the order drawn, who must independently satisfy all requirements of this Section 7.
- This process will repeat down the list of runner-up tickets, if necessary, until a qualifying winner is identified.
- The Foundation reserves the right to decline transfer to any individual it reasonably believes does not qualify under federal or state law, regardless of NICS outcome.

8. Taxes

The Prize has a stated fair market value of \$2,500. The winner is solely responsible for any and all federal, state, and local tax liability arising from receipt of the Prize. The Foundation will issue an IRS Form 1099-MISC to the winner reflecting the fair market value of the Prize, as required by law, and will request a completed Form W-9 from the winner prior to transfer. The Foundation makes no representation

regarding the winner's individual tax consequences and recommends the winner consult a tax professional.

9. Release, Waiver, and Disclaimer

By purchasing a ticket and/or accepting the Prize, each entrant and winner agrees to release, waive, and hold harmless the 906 Foundation, [PLEA], and their respective directors, officers, employees, and agents from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, or losses arising out of or related to: (a) participation in this Raffle; (b) the transfer, possession, use, or misuse of the Prize; (c) any tax liability arising from receipt of the Prize; and (d) any defect in, or the condition of, the firearm, which is transferred **"as-is," with no warranties of any kind, express or implied**. The winner will be required to sign a written release and waiver, in a form provided by the Foundation, as a condition of receiving the Prize.

10. Compliance with Law

This Raffle is conducted pursuant to the nonprofit raffle exemption in A.R.S. § 13-3302(B). No member, director, officer, employee, or agent of the Foundation or PLEA receives, directly or indirectly, any pecuniary benefit from this Raffle other than the ability to participate on the same basis as any other member of the public where otherwise eligible (subject to Section 3's exclusion of Board members and PLEA employees, who remain fully ineligible). No person other than a bona fide local member of the Foundation may participate in the management, sale, or operation of the Raffle. All firearm transfers will occur through the Federal Firearms License held by On Duty Direct Corp. and will comply with the federal Gun Control Act, ATF regulations, and applicable Arizona law.

11. General

The Foundation reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify this Raffle, or these Rules, at any time for any reason permitted by law, including if required by a change in law or regulation. These Rules are governed by the laws of the State of Arizona.
